THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SOUTHEAST MISSOURI HOSPITAL

November 19, 1974

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees was saddened by the loss of TED R. REGENHARDT on October 31, 1974, as an Honorary Member of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Ted R. Regenhardt replaced J. S. N. Farquhar on the Board of Trustees February 16, 1954, and served as an Active Member of the Board of Trustees until April 4, 1967, when he took Honorary Membership on the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Ted R. Regenhardt served as Chairman of the Building and Grounds Committee for several years during which time he supervised the installation of the first paved parking area for the Hospital on the northwest corner of the property on which the building is located; and

WHEREAS, Ted R. Regenhardt served as a faithful member of various committees including that of the Executive Committee, the Rates & Rooms Committee, various fund raising committees, and the Special Events Committee which included arrangements for the Annual Hospital Association Meeting; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Southeast Missouri Hospital extends to the family of Ted R. Regenhardt their deepest sympathy in their less and expresses their appreciation for the many years of service of Mr. Regenhardt; and declares this Resolution to become a permanent part of the Hospital records.
