Be it remembered, that Stephen Delardos
then residing at number 631 Adams Street,
City of Gary State of Indiana, who previous
to his naturalization was a citizen subject of Turkey, having applied to be admitted a
citizen of the United States of America pursuant to law, and at a regular term of the Lake Superior
Court of Lake County held at Gary, Indiana on the 14th day of September
in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-five, the court having found that the petitioner had resided con-
tinuously within the United States for at least five years, and in this State for at least one year immediately preceding the
date of the filing of his petition, and that said petitioner intends to reside permanently in the United States, had in all
respects complied with the law in relation thereto, and that he was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon
ordered by the said court that he be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America.

In testimony whereof the seal of said court is hereunto affixed on the 14th day of September
in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-five, and of our Independence the
one hundred and forty-ninth.
