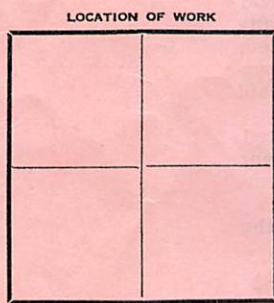
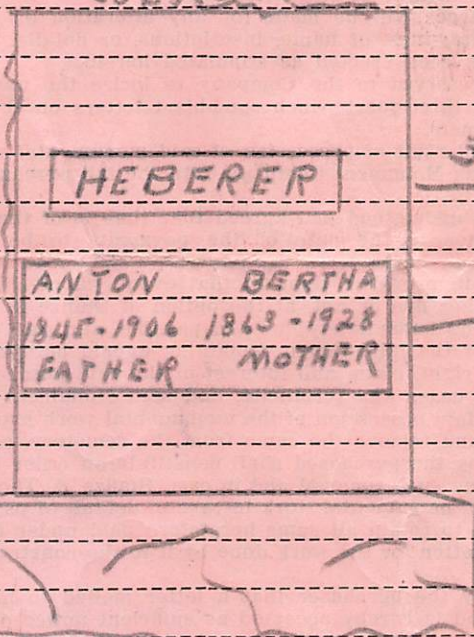

This order becomes a binding contract when an officer of Stanze & Thomas Monument Company accepts it by affixing his signature hereto, and is not subject to cancellation by either party.

The terms of this contract, as they appear printed and written on this sheet, comprise the entire agreement between the parties, and no other agreement or modification of any kind will be recognized, unless the same is in writing, signed by the parties hereto.

Owing to the impossibility in every instance of cutting to exact dimensions, the term "general dimensions" shall be construed to mean a variation of no more than three per cent in any measurement.

All contracts are subject to the Foundation and Setting Rules of the cemetery wherein the work is erected.

All contracts are subject to delays occasioned by fire, accident, strikes, or other causes beyond the control of the Company.

Additional charges will be made for any alteration or additional layouts of the original working drawings, of name, inscriptions, or details, as also for any resetting after the work has been erected as stipulated herein.

The right is reserved to the Company to incise the name: "Stanze & Thomas Monument Co." in three-quarter-inch sand-blast letters on the side or rear of bottom base of the monument.

The title to and right of possession of said monumental work shall be and remain in Stanze & Thomas Monument Company until the full purchase price stipulated herein has been paid.

It is expressly understood and agreed that time is of the essence of this contract so far as it relates to the date of the payments to be made under the terms hereof, and if default be made in the payment of the instalments to be paid by the purchaser, as herein provided, then, in that event, all of said installments remaining unpaid shall, whether due or not, at the option of Stanze & Thomas Monument Company, be and become immediately due and payable, and said Company may proceed to enforce payment of the full amount remaining unpaid hereunder; or, at the option of said Company, all right, claim and interest of the said purchaser in and to said monumental work shall cease and terminate, and said Monument Company shall have the right to the immediate possession of the monumental work made and erected hereunder, and may recover and remove the same from the cemetery, and in such case this contract duly signed by the purchaser shall constitute an order by said purchaser to said cemetery authorizing such removal and in case Stanze & Thomas Monument Company shall take back said monumental work in case of default of payment, as above provided, it shall be entitled to retain all sums heretofore paid under this contract by said purchaser as compensation for the work done by it in the construction and erection of said monumental work.

It is agreed by the purchaser that a letter mailed to him at his address stated hereon, shall be and is hereby accepted as sufficient notice of any default in payment hereunder by him and of the option exercised by Stanze & Thomas Monument Company, as herein provided.
