

Regenhardt in Postmaster Race

Ted R. Regenhardt, former Cape County collector of revenue, has been advanced to the eligible list for the Cape Girardeau postmastership. Rush H. Limbaugh Jr., county Republican chairman, was advised Thursday.

Mr. Regenhardt, now employed at the McDonald Concrete Ready Mix Co., joins Kenneth Cruse and U. G. Pettigrew on the list of eligibles for the position.

Mr. Limbaugh said the move was made by the Civil Service Commission and certified to the state Republican committee, which notified him.

He said he is calling a meeting of the members of the county committee who live in the Cape Girardeau postoffice service area for July 14 to endorse one of the three nominees.

The vacancy on the list of eligibles was made by the withdrawal of Narvol A. Randol, who had been nominated by the President, when he took an executive position at Farmers & Merchants Bank.
