3<sup>d</sup> After all my just debts, expenses during my last sickness, funeral expenses and the foregoing legacies are paid, I hereby give and bequeath the remainder of my Estate, of whatsoever name or description the same may be, to the following named children and grandchildren in the following manner and proportion, to wit:

a. To my daughter Wilhelmine Raths, of the City of St. Louis, Mo., the undivided one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the remainder,

b. To my daughter Auguste Shelwin, in St. Louis, Mo., the undivided one fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the remainder,

c. To my grandchildren Mina Stoffregen, Helena Stoffregen and Frederick Stoffregen, (children of my

daughter Julia Stoffregen, deceased) in common, the undivided one fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the remainder.

4<sup>th</sup> I hereby nominate and appoint Frederick Regenhart, as sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former will by me made.
