LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT I, John T. McNeely of the County of Cape Girardeau, State of Missouri being of sound mind and memory, and realizing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death, do make and publish this, my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, in manner and form following:

- First: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my hereinafter named executrix as soon after my demise as may be convenient.
- Second: I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Jennie S. McNeely all the property of which I may die seized, be the same real estate, personal property, or mixed, to be her property so long as she lives with the right and privilege to sell and <u>dis-of</u> any or all of it.
- Third: After the death of the said my beloved wife Jennie S. McNeely, or at her re-marriage, it is my will that all the balance then left of my estate be divided, share and share alke, among my three daughters, Mrs. Onis Poe, Mrs. Elsie Tuschhoff and Mrs. Lois A. Regenhardt.

 This shall include all property, real estate and personal, not disposed of by my said wife during her lifetime.

And, last, I hereby constitute and appoint my daughter Onis Poe to be the executrix of this, my Last Will and Testament* and it is my request that she permitted to as executrix without giving any bond, revoking and annuling all former wills by me made, and ratifying and confirming this, and no other, to be my Last Will and Testament.
