She passed to her eternal peace at 3 oclock Munday morning June 11, 1945 at the home of her daughter Mrs. T.R. Regenhardt of Cape Girardeau.

She was educated at Brazau Mo. High school and State College Cape G. She united with the Apple Creek Church in 1882 later transferred to Fairview Methodist Church in 1891 .

December 12, 1889 she married John T. McNeely . Their children are Mrs. T.R. Regenhardt , Cape Girardeau, Mrs. Ed Tuschoff, Old Appelon and Mrs. Onus Poe of St. Louis all of whom are here today. One daughter Bessie preceeded her mother in death Nov. 17, 1937. Her husband John preceeded Mrs. McNeely in death May 15 , 1941.

Six grand children survive Mrs. Irlene Abram of St. Louis, Pvt. Slean Tuschoff in the Phillipine Islands , Miss Alice Regenhardt Columbia Mo. Captain Howard Poe in Europe, Donald Regenhardt of Cape Girardeau, and Mrs. Virginia Bond in California. A number of nieces and nephews also survive.

Mrs. McNeely was a charter member of the Ladies Aid Society of Fairview Church as of March 14, 1907; a member of the W.C.T.U. and a most valued member of the Church where her membership remains. She was loyal to the Sunday School class at Grace Church, to her Pastor wherever she happened to reside. Friends, relatives, and all of us will always revere her as a saint who lived as she died in the Love and devotion to her only Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
